Attention: Revised Reimbursement Methodology for Medicare/Medicaid Dually Eligible Clients



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Pursuant to the recent changes to Social Services Law, the NYS Department of Health has revised the Medicaid reimbursement methodology for practitioner claims for Medicare/Medicaid dually eligible individuals. Medicaid no longer reimburses partial Medicare Part B coinsurance amounts when the Medicare payment exceeds the Medicaid fee or rate for that service.

This change to the reimbursement methodology is effective for dates of service on and after **July 1, 2015**. **Claims with dates of service 7/1/15 or after that were processed before the revision of payment methodology was implemented on 12/17/15 are now being adjusted so that correct payment can be made. These adjustments will start to be seen on cycle 2007 with check/EFTs dated 2/8/16.**

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
