Reminder of 10/8 ePACES change due to ICD-10 implementation

As of today, **October 8, 2015**, the diagnosis version indicator in **ePACES claims defaults to ICD-10**.

If you are submitting a claim with a date of service **prior to October 1, 2015**, you will need to **change the version indicator from ICD-10 to ICD-9**, otherwise the claim will be rejected.
