



Important Message Regarding Medicare Part B Claims Submitted by Pharmacies

Effective 05/24/18, pharmacies will be allowed to submit Medicare B drugs via the medical claim format, for automated crossover claims only when billing Medicaid secondary for Medicare Part B patient responsibility amounts. This is the result of a system fix to correct an error that occurred with the implementation of the April 21, 2016, reimbursement logic for Medicare B pharmacy claims.

Pharmacy Providers will now receive the response returned on their electronic 835, PDF or paper Remittance Advice.

eMedNY uses the Default Electronic Transmitter Identification Number (ETIN), linked to your MMIS Provider Number/NPI, for reporting automated Medicare crossover claims on your electronic or PDF remittance. In order to receive these Medicare crossover claims on your remittance statements, you will need to verify you have selected a Default ETIN, and make sure the ETIN is current with its Certification.
