

## Pricing Methodology Change for Hearing Aids

Recent regulation changes to 18 NYCRR 505.31 created a new Medicaid pricing methodology for hearing aids. The changes are a result of the Medicaid Redesign Team's recommendation to increase the efficiency of the Medicaid program by reducing the administrative burden on hearing aid providers to obtain claims payment.

As a result, initial Maximum Reimbursable Amounts (MRAs) have been established for hearing aid procedure codes effective for dates of service on and after August 1, 2014. If needed, manual pricing for charges above the MRA will be available through October 31, 2014. The MRAs will become final effective dates of service on and after November 1, 2014. During this three month transition, if a provider has invoices or other manufacturer product information that could impact an MRA, please forward that information to [ohipmedpa@health.state.ny.us](mailto:ohipmedpa@health.state.ny.us)

With the new MRA pricing methodology, hearing aid providers will no longer be required to submit paper claims and invoices for manual pricing of hearing aids billed over the former "screen" prices. MRAs are determined for each item based on an average cost of products representative of that item. This enables providers to bill claims electronically. The initial MRAs listed below were established based on a two year review of actual claims payment and invoices. The August 1, 2014 fee schedule with the hearing aid MRAs is available at:
