

## Ostomy and External Urinary Supplies

**Please make the following changes in the Procedure Code and Fee Schedule sections of your Pharmacy and DME Provider Manuals (Rev. 4/2012).**

The following changes are effective for dates of service on or after November 1<sup>st</sup> 2012. New HCPCS codes have been added as covered Ostomy supplies (**bolded**). All Ostomy supply codes will now require a DVS authorization. The MRA's for HCPCS codes A4357 and A4379 have been updated.
