**NYRx, The Medicaid Pharmacy Program
Claims Submitted 4/1 - 4/4/2023**

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Beginning April 1, 2023, all Medicaid members in Mainstream Managed Care started receiving their prescription drugs through NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program.

NYRx system updates were made on 4/4/2023 at 12 PM EST. If a claim was submitted between 4/1/2023-4/4/2023 and a rejection was received the pharmacy can resubmit the claim to NYRx today. Additional updates and information will be shared as available.

Practitioner Administered Drugs (PADs)

The list of [PADs Added to the NYRx Formulary](#) was updated on 3/30/2023. NYS DOH recognizes the need for certain drugs requiring administration by a practitioner to be available through the Medical and Pharmacy Benefit. Practitioner administered drugs that are listed on the [eMedNY "Medicaid Pharmacy List of Reimbursable Drugs" web page](#) may be billed directly to NYRx under the pharmacy benefit. PADs obtained by the practitioner, must be billed as a medical claim to the Medicaid Managed Care Plan of the member.

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
