Attention: Providers of Reproductive Health Services



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Effective for dates of service on or after October 1, 2015, all Medicaid providers, including providers of reproductive health services, must use the ICD-10 diagnosis codes on all claims submitted to Medicaid.

For family planning service providers this means that effective October 1, 2015, ICD-10-CM codes in the Z30 series will replace the ICD-9-CM codes in the V25 series. Please refer to [January 2016 Medicaid Update](#) for a complete listing of family planning diagnoses and CPT codes.

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New York State Medicaid pays for medically necessary abortions. For dates of service on or after October 1, 2015, claims submitted to eMedNY for an abortion should have the ICD-10-CM Z33.2 code which replaces the ICD-9-CM 635 series.

Reminder: There has been no change to the requirement that a condition code be included on all claims submitted to eMedNY for an abortion. Providers must make every effort to ensure the **appropriate** condition code for each unique scenario is attached to the claim.
