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Final Notice for 5010/D.0 Compliance

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS) discretionary enforcement period for HIPAA Versions 5010 and D.0 will expire on June 30, 2012. Consistent with this guideline, **New York Medicaid will no longer be able to accept HIPAA Version 4010 and NCPDP Version 5.1 effective on July 1, 2012.**

Beginning on July 1, 2012 files sent to eMedNY with ASC X12 Version 4010 transactions or NCPDP 5.1 will be rejected by an "F" file with the following message:

**"This Version of the X12 (or NCPDP) is Not Supported
**** FILE REJECTED ****"**

This applies to files submitting claims, claim status requests, eligibility requests and prior authorizations.
