The New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) will be transitioning to ICD-10 diagnosis and procedures codes on October 1, 2014. This transition is required for providers and payers covered by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). The transition to ICD-10 will not impact CPT codes.
