We are very pleased to provide you with the <u>December 2019</u> <u>Medicaid Update</u> article that was recently published by the Department of Health relative to the launch of the New York State Medicaid Program's coverage of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) National Diabetes Prevention Program (NDPP) for Medicaid Fee-For-Service (FFS), and Medicaid Managed Care (MMC) members.

The December 2019 Medicaid Update article presents information for providers interested in becoming a Medicaid-enrolled NDPP service provider. Medicaid FFS NDPP provider enrollment is **<u>now</u>** available for any CDC recognized organizations or individuals via the eMedNY NDPP provider enrollment page located at https://www.emedny.org/info/ProviderEnrollment/NDPP/.

Reimbursement for NDPP services became available for both Medicaid FFS and MMC claims submitted for dates of service on or after **February 1, 2020**. Once the completed NDPP provider enrollment application has been reviewed and approved, the Medicaid provider enrollment file is backdated 90 days, but not to exceed the February 1, 2020 date in which NDPP reimbursement became available.
