Threshold Override Applications (TOA) Require ICD10 Diagnosis Codes

The Utilization Threshold (UT) program limits the number of times Medicaid members can receive certain medical services in a benefit year. Increases in a member's UT service limits can only be granted upon submission of a TOA.

As of October 1, 2015 only ICD10 diagnosis codes are acceptable on the TOA form. TOAs received with ICD9 codes will be denied.
