Important ICD-10 Information for Managed Care Providers



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The implementation of ICD-10 diagnosis codes occurred Thursday, October 1, 2015. Managed Care Plan capitation claims are submitted to eMedNY in the X12 837 Institutional format. The 837I format requires a diagnosis code to be submitted on every capitation claim. Therefore, for submission of October capitation claims, Managed Care Plans are reminded that an ICD-10 diagnosis code must be included in that submission or the claims will be rejected by eMedNY.

Capitation claims that are submitted with dates October 1, 2015 and forward must contain an ICD-10 diagnosis code. The New York State Department of Health is recommending the use of ICD-10 code **R69** – “Illness, unspecified” with the ICD-10 qualifier “**ABK**” to replace the ICD-9 code 7999.
