PA/DVS Transactions Must be Submitted with a Certified ETIN

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Attention ePACES Users: If you submit Prior Approval (PA) or Dispensing Validation System (DVS) transactions through ePACES and are currently enrolled into ePACES with a MEVS Only (Temporary) ETIN (this type of ETIN will start with a symbol ex: #), please be aware that in the near future Temporary ETINs will no longer be able to submit PA or DVS requests.

In order to continue to submit these transactions you will need to enroll into ePACES with a certified ETIN. If you do not have a certified ETIN, please complete and submit the request found **here**.

After you have received a new ETIN number, please go towww.emedny.org/enroll or call 1-800-343-9000 for instructions on how to enroll your certified ETIN with ePACES.

If you are uncertain if you are using a Temporary ETIN with ePACES, you can determine your ETIN by clicking the "Submitter" link in ePACES. Temporary ETINs begin with a symbol such as \$ or #. Certified ETINs begin with a letter or a number.
