ePACES Changes Coming With The Implementation of ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes Next Week (October 1, 2015)

As you are aware, eMedNY will require the use of ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes for dates of service October 1, 2015 and after. Beginning on October 1, ePACES users will begin to see a pop-up when entering the ePACES application to alert them of the following change:

On the Diagnosis Tab, the Diagnosis Version (ICD-9 or ICD-10) is currently defaulted to ICD-9. Beginning next Thursday, if the submitted claim has a date of service October 1, 2015 or after, users will need to select the ICD-10 version.

Also be aware that on October 8, 2015 the Diagnosis Version will default to ICD-10. Therefore if a user is submitting a transaction with a date of service **prior** to October 1, 2015, she/he will need to change the version from ICD-10 to ICD-9.
