PA/DVS Transactions Must be Submitted with a Certified ETIN Starting September 15, 2011

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Attention ePACES Users: Starting Thursday, September 15, 2011, Prior Approval (PA) or Dispensing Validation System (DVS) transactions submitted with a **MEVS Only (Temporary) ETIN** (ETINs starting with a symbol ex: #) **are no longer allowed by the system**. In order to continue to submit PA or DVS ePACES transactions, you must be enrolled into ePACES with a certified ETIN.

To determine whether you are using a Temporary ETIN, click the "Submitter" link in ePACES to determine your ETIN type. Temporary ETINs begin with a symbol such as \$ or #. Certified ETINs begin with a letter or a number.

After you have received a new ETIN number, please go to www.emedny.org/enroll or call 1-800-343-9000 for instructions on how to enroll your certified ETIN with ePACES.
