### Attention Transportation Providers: Zero-Fill Claims After Medicare Must Be Submitted Electronically



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Claims submitted to Medicaid after Medicare, when Medicare does not cover the service and you are zero-filling, must be billed electronically. If you are billing Medicaid using paper Claim Form A, and submitting zero-fill reimbursement from Medicare, these claims will be denied edit 00152- (Recipient Has Medicare, No Medicare Present).

Transportation providers must submit zero-filled claims with Medicare involvement electronically, either using the appropriate CARC from Medicare, or entering a non-covered charge. Medicaid uses the CARC or non-covered charge in claims processing to ensure proper payment. CARCs and non-covered charges cannot be submitted on a Medicaid paper claim submission appropriately. For proper payment, it is best to bill electronically with the supplied CARC.
