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Retroactive Repricing Update

Starting May 2, 2019, the Department will resume the retroactive repricing project associated with changes to the pharmacy reimbursement previously mentioned in the [January 2018 Medicaid Update](#).

The Department will re-start the process to retroactively adjust pharmacy claims (excluding claims for drug NDCs previously identified with issues) that were adjudicated effective June 30, 2017 through February 21, 2018. The Department expects this repricing to take place over the course of several months and anticipates that it will be completed sometime in September 2019. Providers will begin to see adjustments beginning with remittance cycle 2177. Please see remittance schedule here:

Adjustments made to affected claims will be found on the remittance statement. The remittance statement will show a credit, which retracts the initial payment, and a debit at the new amount. Guidelines for remittance advise can be found here:

The remaining claims for drug NDCs previously identified with issues, will be processed after a system project is complete. The Department will communicate a timeframe for this as we get closer to the completion of the project.
