## Your Medicaid Enrollment – Clinics, Clinical Social Workers (CSW)

Federal regulation 42 CFR, Part 455.414 requires New York State Medicaid to revalidate your enrollment every five years. Revalidation involves completion of the enrollment form and submission of all required documents.

Clinics include: Ambulatory Surgery Centers, Diagnostic and Treatment Centers, Hemodialysis Centers.

You can save time and money by coordinating your New York State Medicaid revalidation with Medicare, another state's Medicaid program or CHIP Program. If you revalidate with New York within 12 months of your Medicare/state Medicaid/CHIP revalidation, the New York application fee will be waived.

The Revalidation process for Clinics and CSWs will begin in January. Revalidation letters will be mailed to Clinics and CSW providers actively submitting claims to Medicaid. Find out more about Revalidation by clicking on the links below.
