Process Update: EVV Attestation now to be Completed in the Provider Enrollment Portal

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Providers are responsible for ensuring that their EVV systems meet the intent of the 21st Century Cures Act and adhere to New York State state-specific requirements as outlined on the NY Medicaid Electronic Visit Verification Program (EVV) <u>website</u>, in the <u>EVV</u> <u>Program Guidelines and Requirements</u>, and in the Interface Control Document (ICD).

One of the EVV requirements is each EVV provider <u>must</u> <u>annually submit an EVV Attestation Form</u>. Please be reminded that annual attestations for compliance year 2023 are upcoming.

Process Update: As of April 1, 2022, the EVV Attestation Form, required to be completed annually by providers subject to EVV, is now located in the Provider Enrollment (PE) Portal. EVV attestation functionality will no longer be in the Provisional Temporary Enrollment (PTPE) Portal as it had been previously.

If you had previously registered for the Provisional Temporary Provider Enrollment (PTPE) Portal to complete your EVV Attestation Form, you will need to re-register using the Provider Enrollment (PE) Portal and complete the current EVV Attestation Form there. If you already have a Provider Enrollment (PE) Portal account, no re-registration is required.
