Attention Managed Care Plans: 834 Enrollment File Naming Convention Change

Beginning on **January 28, 2022**, Managed Care plans will begin to receive their 005010X220A1 Benefit Enrollment and Maintenance (834) – Enrollment files with the Provider MMIS ID (Medicaid Management Information System Identification) on their files. This change is to assist Managed Care plans to recognize for internal sorting/delivery when a file is for their Managed Care Daily Enrollment Roster without having to interrogate the data within the file (open the file).

eMedNY will add the MMIS ID to the second node of the file name. Sample file names are included for reference. **NOTE:** Only the extracted file with the 834 data will have the name change applied; the delivery ZIP or TAR file will remain unchanged.

 - Delivery Container -TAR: R211208032401..834-.tar
 - Once extracted. R211208032400.01234567.834.0000.x12

FTP/VPN File Naming Conventions

- Current File Name
 - Delivery Container-ZIP: P0123456.D211208.ZIP
 - Once extracted: R211208032400..834.0000
- Future File Name
 - Delivery Container-ZIP: P0123456.D211208.ZIP
 - Once extracted: R211208032400.01234567.834.0000
